



Disease Control :

Westwood ISD health services operates under the approved health rules, regulations and standards adopted by the Anderson County Health Department in accordance with the Texas Department of Health Services.

If students have the following symptoms please do not send them to school unless they have been seen by a physician or symptoms are gone:

- Temperature 100.0 or above
- Rash or intense itching
- Scaly white patch on scalp
- Red draining eyes
- Nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea
- Open draining lesions
- Lice
- Signs of Jaundice (yellowing of the skin)
- Pain or swelling of the jaw

Please do not give the child medication for a fever and send them to school anyway. He/she must be fever free for 24 hours.
Lesions that are scabbed over must be covered.

If the student is found to have one or more of the conditions listed above, the student will be sent home and a Doctor's note will be required prior to the student returning to school.
